Workshop Covers Best Practices in Airfield Concrete Pavements

Rosemont, Illinois (August 22, 2014) – The American Concrete Pavement Association (ACPA) announced it will present a comprehensive, three-day workshop covering best practices in airfield pavement design and construction.

The course will be held October 14 through 16 at ACPA's Rosemont, Ill.-headquarters, located at 9450 W. Bryn Mawr Ave., Rosemont, Illinois. This special training event will be held in the 3rd floor conference room.

The curriculum is well suited for contractors; airport owners and owners' representatives; consultants/engineers; inspectors; military engineers; Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) personnel, and others with an interest in designing, constructing, and maintaining quality concrete pavements for commercial airports and military airfield applications.

Leading experts from the American Concrete Pavement Association, the Federal Aviation Administration, and other companies in the airport construction community will present information and lead open discussions.

In addition to providing comprehensive information about airport pavement design & construction, it will also cover various specifications (i.e., P-501, Unified Facilities Guide Specifications, etc.); advisory circulars; engineering briefs; and other resources.

Just a few of the topic areas that will be covered in the workshop include foundation support, jointing, concrete mixtures, stockpiling, concrete plant management, acceptance criteria, smoothness, and much more.

Participants will have the opportunity to earn up to 20 professional development hours (PDH's) for the successful completion of the course. ACPA encourages participants to confirm the acceptance of ACPA-issued PDH's with licensing organizations in their state/province.
