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### DESCRIPTION:

Entities that manufacture or supply essential materials (other than Portland cement, supplementary cementitious materials, or ready mix concrete) for use by contractors directly in pavement construction, rehabilitation or maintenance are eligible. After joining, all members shall be deemed to have agreed to be bound by the Association's Articles of Incorporation, bylaws, policies approved by the Board of Directors, affiliation agreements with chapters or affiliates of the Association, and all obligations contained in any of those documents. All memberships are considered active unless a resignation letter is received in writing at the Association headquarters office.

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### ACPA MEMBERSHIP IS TAX DEDUCTIBLE:

The American Concrete Pavement Association (ACPA) is a 501(c)6 organization. For federal tax purposes, contributions to the ACPA are a deductible business expense. **For 2024, 4.65% of membership dues is classified as lobbying activities and is not tax deductible per IRS regulations.** For 2024, no portion of ACPA dues are contributed to political campaigns or candidates.

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### CONTRIBUTION TO INNOVATIVE PAVEMENT RESEARCH FOUNDATION:

ACPA maintains a commitment to research and education on behalf of the industry. A voluntary member contribution designated for the Innovative Pavement Research Foundation (IPRF), a 501(c)3 organization operated by ACPA will be restricted for use in funding research and education priorities. The IPRF applies its funds toward projects that meet the strategic intent of the concrete pavement industry, such as:

- **Performance-Engineered Concrete Mixtures** – an effort shared by the ACPA/IPRF and its partner, National Concrete Pavement Technology Center to develop new mixture design procedures for concrete paving mixtures. Performance-engineered mixtures will better ensure concrete pavement applications will meet and/or exceed the intended design life without premature materials-related durability problems.
  - **Concrete Overlays** – an effort shared by the ACPA/IPRF and its partner, National Concrete Pavement Technology Center to refine and implement improved guidance on concrete overlays for existing concrete or asphalt pavements.
  - **Technology Transfer and Education** – an effort directed toward the development knowledgeable engineers about concrete pavement and the concrete pavement industry.

- Note 1.** Local dues for cement, fly ash and other pozzolan suppliers are \$500 plus an assessment administered separately by the chapter; All other material member dues are \$250.
- Note 2.** Chapter applies a volume assessment in addition to this minimum annual rate. Assessments are handled separately by the chapter. Call the chapter for their specific rates and process.
- Note 3.** Admixture, aggregate and fly ash supplier dues are \$1250; All other materials member dues are \$700.
- Note 4.** Chapter applies a volume assessment in addition to this minimum annual rate for fly ash slag and water-reducing admixture suppliers. The assessment is invoiced and collected through the chapter. Call the chapter for their specific rates and process.
- Note 5.** Portland/blended cement suppliers are based on an assessment administered by ACPA/PA. Supplemental cementitious supplier annual dues are \$3,000. Aggregate and admixture suppliers are \$1,500. Ready-mixed producers are \$300. All other material suppliers are \$800.
- Note 6.** Aggregate and pozzolans (fly ash, slag) supplier dues are \$1250; All other materials member dues are \$800.
- Note 7.** Local dues for admixture suppliers are \$1000; All other materials member dues are \$500.
- Note 8.** Chapter applies a volume assessment for Fly Ash Producers in addition to this minimum annual rate. Assessments are added on separate invoices from the chapter. Call the chapter for their specific rates.
- Note 9.** Dues are based on volume. (0-\$500,000; \$500,001-\$1,000,000; or over \$1,000,000).
- Note 10.** Dues are \$2000 for concrete or aggregate producer/supplier and materials hauler – aggregates, flyash, cement. Dues are \$3000 for admixtures material supplier and cement or SCM manufacturer/supplier.
